

Dear CPN Chairman or Legislative Candidate,

Now that you have made the decision to seek an opportunity to serve your fellow Citizen Potawatomi Nation members, the CPN Public Information Department is available to assist in taking your message to the voters.

First, we need information to include in your *free* one-fourth (1/4)-page ad in the February 2009 edition, of the *HowNiKan*. Please send a photo of yourself along with the text and other graphic elements for your ad to the *HowNiKan* via regular mail (HowNiKan, Citizen Potawatomi Nation, 1601 S. Gordon Cooper Dr., Shawnee, OK 74801) or e-mail ([MDodson@Potawatomi.org](mailto:MDodson@Potawatomi.org)). I need to have information for free ads for the February edition no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, February 10, 2009.

Two candidates have *purchased* ads for the January edition of the *HowNiKan*. Any candidate who wants to do the same may do so. I do need to have the materials for your ad no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, February 2, 2009. For purchased ads, make checks payable to Citizen Potawatomi Nation. Send them to *HowNiKan* Ads, Citizen Potawatomi Nation, 1601 S. Gordon Cooper Dr., Shawnee, OK 74801. Payment for an ad must be in hand before it will be published.

The size of a one-fourth (1/4)-page ad is 25 square inches. A landscape-perspective ad will be 4.917 inches wide (two *HowNiKan* columns) by 5.1 inches tall. A portrait-perspective ad will be 2.375 inches wide (one *HowNiKan* column) by 10.5 inches tall. You may purchase as many additional ads of whatever size you prefer in the February, March, April, May, and June editions of the *HowNiKan*. Please provide all materials for ads for the March edition no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, February 27, 2009. Deadlines for remaining pre-election editions of the *HowNiKan* are Friday, March 27, 2009; Friday, April 24, 2009; and Friday, May 22, 2009.

It would also be very helpful if you can provide the Public Information Department a curriculum vitae, resume, or list of jobs/positions you have held in your working career. If you have an e-mail address, please ensure that we have it here at the Public Information Department. Communication about ads and other matters will be much easier and quicker if it can be handled electronically.
